Q1. What are the entry procedures and quarantine requirements for travelers coming to Taiwan?

- 1.Please refer to the "Instructions for passengers before arriving in Taiwan and clearance at the airport" (https://gov.tw/VP2).
- 2.With the steady return to regular management of the border quarantine, inbound travelers should practice seven-day self-initiated prevention. Travelers who have experienced any suspected COVID-19 symptoms in the 14 days before arrival should truthfully notify Taiwan CDC quarantine personnel of discomfort or symptoms and cooperate to do a health assessment. Travelers need to do a rapid test if they have any symptoms during their stay in Taiwan.

Q1-1. What requirements must confirmed cases or previously infected individuals meet before taking a flight to Taiwan?

Travelers who test positive abroad are required to wait over five days from their specimen collection date before taking a flight to Taiwan in order to prevent cross-border transmission of the disease.
